

## Copyright Declaration of Active Participants of the 6th Congress of Polish Statistics

(Warsaw, 1–2 July 2026)

Legal basis:

1. Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of April 27, 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) (Official Journal of the EU L 119 of 04.05.2016, p. 1, as amended).
